Read the following text carefully and answer the questions.

Text:

In my view, environmentalism, rightly understood, is patriotism. The word comes from the Latin root "patria": fatherland or homeland. So, patriotism would seem to indicate a general concern to protect the land and the people of one's homeland, however extensively one defines them. On this view, environmentalists are patriots par excellence, literally committed to protecting the land and all its inhabitants, including its non-human inhabitants.

Environmental activists typically work to protect the places they know and love, whether it is open-space threatened by sprawl, or a downtown threatened by a new Super Wal-Mart. They involve themselves in their communities: leading hikes to teach boy scouts and girl scouts about the plants and animals around them, or tipping off reporters to illegal dumping. They hand out campaign literature for green candidates and pack city council meetings to argue about zoning changes. They do all this not to make a buck, but because they care about where they live and other special places they have gotten to know, and because they want to preserve them for their children and grandchildren.

Environmentalists don't only protect these places; they celebrate them as well: hiking and camping and kayaking and skinny-dipping to show their patriotic attachment to their country. Just as a 4th of July parade with marching bands provides a sense of belonging and larger community to many, so may a hike up Long's Peak, or an Audubon Society field trip to watch the birds at a local reservoir. In these activities, people bond with the land and with each other. They come face to face with what will otherwise remain mere abstractions: biodiversity. They learn the history of the natural and human communities of which they are parts. They come to see their own lives as parts of larger stories, their own efforts as parts of larger struggles and achievements.
